

Cooroy-Noosa Road and Sivyers Road, Tinbeerwah

Safety improvement works

Project notification: June 2021

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise that detailed design is progressing for safety improvement works at the intersection of Cooroy-Noosa Road and Sivyers Road, Tinbeerwah.

TMR will improve safety by providing a dedicated right-turn into Sivyers Road. This will reduce the likelihood and severity of incidents involving through traffic on Cooroy-Noosa Road colliding with right-turning motorists.

The project is funded by the Queensland Government's Targeted Road Safety Program, which aims to improve road safety by implementing high-benefit, cost-effective treatments at known and potential crash locations.

The proposed design includes:

- installing a dedicated right-turn lane into Sivyers Road to provide safer conditions for turning motorists
- upgrading safety barriers at the adjacent Six Mile Creek Bridge
- new signage and linemarking.

Detailed design is expected to be complete by late 2021, with construction to start in 2022, weather and construction scheduling permitting.
