

Eumundi—Noosa Road safety improvements. Works to commence 29 May 2024.

Project notification: May 2024

The Department of Transport and Main Roads' (TMR) contractor will soon begin safety improvements along a section of Eumundi—Noosa Road between Lenehans Lane, Doonan and Beckmans Road, Noosaville.

Works are scheduled to commence **29 May 2024** and will be completed by **early 2025**, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Works will include installing a wide centre line treatment (WCLT) within the project area, road widening and resurfacing, removing hazards along the roadside and providing safer road markings and sealed shoulders for bike riders. These works, in particular the WCLT, will reduce the rate and severity of crashes and improve conditions for all road users.

Safety treatments include:

- increasing separation between lanes of opposing traffic by a WCLT
- road widening and resurfacing
- installing audio tactile linemarking to alert drivers if they drift from their lane
- removing roadside hazards
- providing safety improvements for bike riders, including sealed shoulders and left-turn lanes at key intersections
- installing targeted roadside safety barriers, including motorcycle protection.

What to expect:

- the majority of works will be undertaken **Monday to Friday between 6am and 6pm**
- occasional night works may be undertaken to minimise risks and impacts to motorists and to allow for single-lane closures

- advance notice will be provided to the community via Variable Message Signs (VMS) prior to night works
- left-turn lanes may be closed during works for short periods of time. Motorists will still be able to safely turn left at these times. Right-turn lanes will remain open during works
- traffic controllers, reduced speed limits, road signage and VMS will be in place to ensure motorist and roadworker safety
- nearby residents may experience noise, light, vibration and dust during works
- during works, heavy machinery including excavators, concrete trucks, and mobile cranes may be accessing the work site
- reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used during works
- motorists may experience delays and are encouraged to drive to the changed traffic conditions, obey signage and reduced speed limits at all times
- priority access through the work site will be given to emergency vehicles.

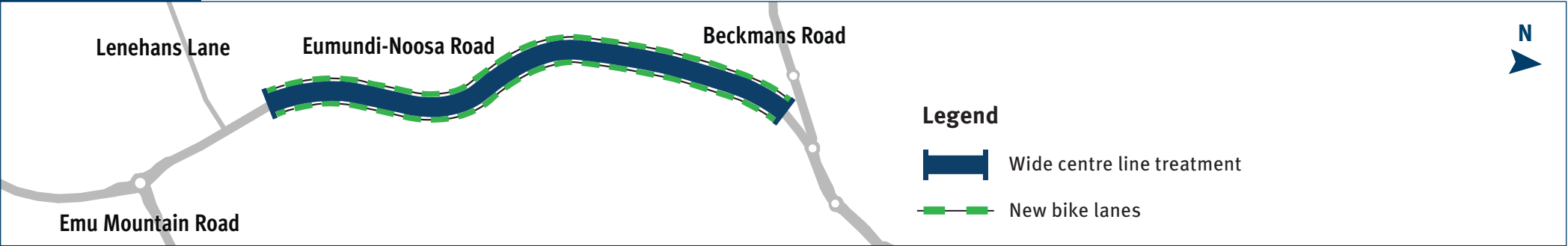
