

Cooroy Connection Road (Myall Street) resurfacing works

Works update: November 2024

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will be undertaking resurfacing works on a 1.3km stretch of Cooroy Connection Road, known locally as Myall Street, in Cooroy. Preliminary and investigative works have been ongoing since August 2024, but the major works were delayed by weather and scheduling issues. Resurfacing and associated activities will now take place from mid-November and take approximately six weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. **Please refer to the design layout overleaf.**

Key works

- Resurfacing a 1.3km stretch of Cooroy Connection Road from just south of Ferrells Road to just east of the railway overpass near the intersection of Myall Street and Elm Street.
- Pavement rehabilitation at the Myall and Elm Street intersection and on approaches to the railway bridge.
- **The railway bridge will be closed when works on the bridge deck take place for up to two nights towards the end of the program – please stay alert to updates displayed on Variable Message Signs.**
- Installation of dedicated right-turn lanes for vehicles travelling south and turning into either Crystal Street, Tulip Street, Ferrells Road, or the high school/swimming club car park.
- Extended no standing zones near Crystal Street.
- Installation of dedicated bike lanes marked at the above intersections.

What to expect

- The majority of the works will be undertaken at night, Sunday to Thursday between 6pm and 6am. Occasional day and weekend works may be required.
- **Detours will be in place while resurfacing takes place on the railway bridge.**
- Reduced speed limits, construction signage and traffic control will be in place throughout the works to ensure motorist and roadworker safety.
- Motorists may experience delays and are encouraged to drive to the changed traffic conditions.
- Nearby residents may experience temporary increases in noise, vibration, brighter lighting and dust while works are underway.
- Priority access will be given to emergency vehicles through the work site.
